The children are invited to dress up as a character from their favourite book on March the 3rd to have some fun with us on World Book Day!


We will be sharing stories, talking about our favourite books and characters and encouraging the children to write or draw a picture about them.

Easter chick nests

Ingredients

200g milk chocolate, broken into pieces
85g shredded wheat, crushed
2 x 100g bags mini chocolate eggs

Cake cases

Melt the chocolate in a small bowl placed over a pan of

barely simmering water. Pour the chocolate over the shredded wheat and stir well to combine.

Spoon the chocolate wheat into 12 cupcake cases and press the back of a teaspoon in the centre to create a nest shape. Place 3 mini chocolate eggs on top of each nest. Chill the nests in the fridge for 2 hours until set.
